PARKS & RECREATION MAINT: Board discussion was held on the need to advertise for a maintenance person for the park. A list of duties will be determined and an ad will be sent to the Reminder/Banner.
BENCHES FROM SCOUTS TROOP #50: Jackie Spencer leader of Troup #50 spoke to members about how the troop has been collecting plastic caps and lids. TOWNSHIP OFFICE ROOF REPLACEMENT BIDS: 3 bids were received. **MOTION** by L. Campbell, second by J. Wooer to accept the bid from Central Michigan roofing. 40 year standing seam metal roofing panel, complete with all ridge-cap, new re-roof drip edge, valley trims, gable trim and all metal fasteners. **\$27,400.25. CEMETERY LAND: Board discussion was held on making an offer on the land for sale behind the church located west of the cemetery. **MOTION** by D. Knight, second by J. Wooer to offer \$10,000 for the land. **ALL AYES. MOTION CARRIED.**

SAFETY NET CHANGE TO LIFECARE AGREEMENT: Board discussion was held on changing the wait time for an ambulance from 30 minutes to 25 minutes.
